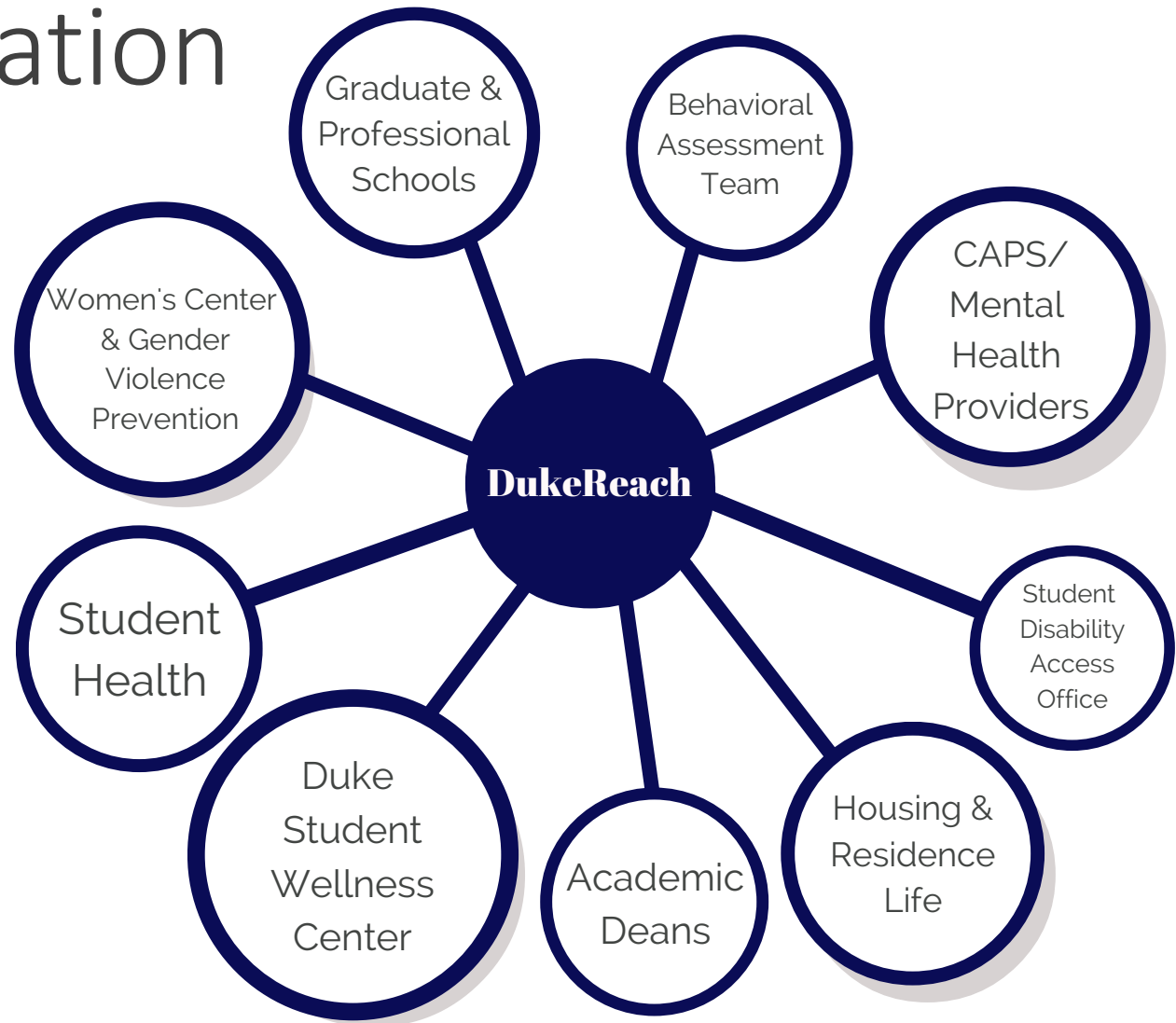




We support students in distress

- Receive reports of students of concern from community members
 - Educate the campus community on the signs of distress in students' lives
 - Provide long-term case management support for students with significant ongoing needs
 - Triage and support students through ALL kinds of distress

The Four Health & Wellness Units

CAPS – 919-660-1000

- Individual Counseling and Group workshops (Koru)

Student Health – 919-681-9355

- Physical Health care, immunizations, and travel clinic

DukeReach – 919-681-2455

- Receives reports of students in distress; offers resource referral and ongoing support for students needing additional assistance

Wellness Center (DUWell) – 919-681-8421

- An overall wellness focus. Allows students to examine how all aspects of life influence overall functioning and wellbeing, e.g., Health Coaching

When to call DukeReach: Faculty/Administrators

A student has stopped showing up to class/appointments, and does not respond to calls/emails.

You notice a worrying change in a student's behavior/presentation (hygiene, weight, affect, etc.).

You are concerned that a student might harm self or others, or need medical/mental health support that s/he is not receiving.
